Virtual Meeting Safety Guidelines

CP Soccer is providing live online group training sessions to players across the country so they can remain active and socially connected.

As part of this offering, virtual online platforms are used to connect players with the coach. These platforms may be used by players under the age of 16. We are particularly committed to protecting the privacy of our players, to this end, CP Soccer follows best practices for security of our virtual soccer field.

This set of guidelines will be sent to all coaches, families, and guests who are involved with a live online group training session.

1. All participants must register before CP Soccer provides them the virtual meeting ID.
2. At least two adults will be on the meeting, one coach, and one other CP Soccer representative.
3. CP Soccer does not use Personal Meeting IDs the virtual meeting rooms of our online trainings. A random meeting ID will be used.
4. CP Soccer uses virtual meeting rooms with two-factor authentication with a meeting ID and user password.
5. All participants must log in to a meeting. Only people with accounts will be able to login to join the meeting.
6. CP Soccer will disable join before host setting. Players will not be able to join the session before the host coach enters the meeting.
7. CP Soccer will lock the virtual meeting room once a session starts.
8. CP Soccer reserves the right to expel any disruptive participants in our meetings.
9. CP Soccer reserves the right to mute any participants in our meetings.
10. All participants are by default muted on entry and stay muted during the virtual meeting unless the coach unmutes them to speak.
11. Participants wishing to speak must raise their hand so the coach can allow them to speak.
12. Participants under the age of 18 must not show their full names on the feed. They can show their first name and last initial.
13. Participants must show their video during the feed to ensure that they are the registered participant.
14. Private chat will be disabled during the course of the session.
15. Parents must remain with the player during the course of the online session.
16. If CP Soccer were to invite guests on the feed, they will first share CP Soccer's child protection policy and virtual meeting policy to the guest.
17. If CP Soccer were to invite guests on the feed, participants will be alerted ahead of time.
18. If CP Soccer were to record a session, parents will be notified ahead of time.
19. CP Soccer reserves the right to deny anyone registration or access to the feed if they are in disagreement or do not comply with CP Soccer rules and guidelines.
